ROLE, RESPONSIBILITY, RESULTS, RELEVANCE AND RISE (FIVE R IN LIBRARY)

Dr. S R Ramganathn had truly mentioned in one of the five laws of Library Science that the library is a growing organism. I would say here that growing means accepting and accommodating changes from all corners of the library and outside. Library is at micro level and at macro level see the bigger changes and how it affects the micro mechanism. As per UN, Population growth was 0.85 in 2024 and during the last five years it remains below 1 percent. As per Ministry of Education "Between 1950-51 and 2021-22, India's Gross Enrollment Ratio

(GER) grew by a remarkable 71 times, showcasing significant progress in increasing student enrollments over the decades.

The GER figures reflect this growth, with 0.4 in 1950-51 and reaching 28.4 in 2021-22. This impressive progress aligns with the goals set by the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, which aims to achieve a GER of 50% by 2035." This indicates that the number of schools, colleges, institutions, Universities and Public Libraries have grown in numbers. These lead to the growth of users' numbers. Technology has progressed fast from punch cards to artificial intelligence. It is up to an individual how much to learn, but we know one statement from New Education Policy 2020 that is "Lifelong Learning." These are external factors but the internal factors at micro level are "POSDCORB". It is a management and administration acronym. It represents the seven key functions of management: Planning, Organizing, Staffing, Directing, Coordinating, Reporting, and Budgeting. It was coined by Luther Gulick and Lyndall Urwick.

Use of Role, Responsibility, Results, Relevant and Rise (five R) in the libraries are another way to look at it and evaluate librarians. **First R** stands for Role. It defines the function of the organization.

Second R is responsibilities. It defines the tasks and duties that are associated with the role. What position and how will he/she perform within the system.

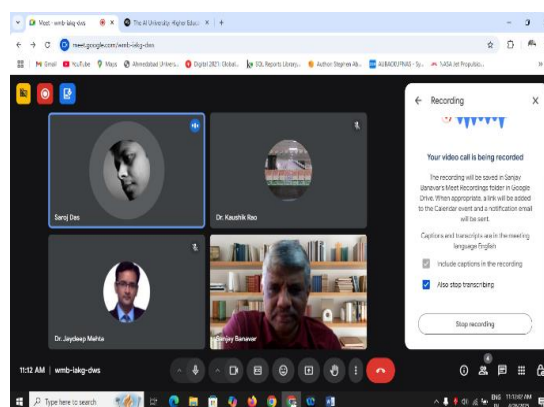
Third R stands for results. This is based on our inputs to UG programmes and students, PG programmes and students, Doctoral Scholars, Research Scholars, Classroom teaching, Contribution to Projects, and Contribution to Research, Faculty, Management and justifying the use of resources etc. This varies from library to library. In other words, it is a Return on Investment.

Fourth R is Relevance, our input to the employers and stakeholders. Relevant results are very important. This is nothing but a mix of theory and practice. This may be an optimum use of library science, Information technology, and content with which you are dealing in your setup.

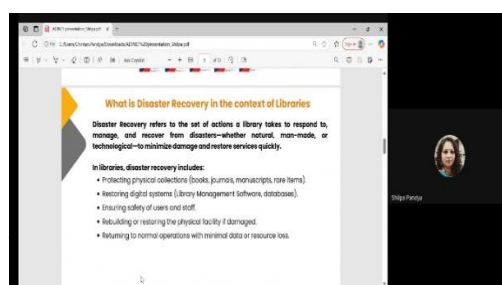
Fifth R is for Rise. This indicates your growth in your organisation based on input, results and how relevant they are to users and to management. Self-Evaluation Model

EDITION OF COLLABORATIVE WISDOM: ONLINE WEBINAR: A REPORT

The April 26, 2025 edition of the ADINET Collaborative Wisdom series focused on “*AI Integration in Libraries*” and was attended by **5 participants**. The session explored the transformative role of Artificial Intelligence in redefining library services, shifting from traditional reference support to smart, and user-centered knowledge delivery. Participants shared how AI tools are enabling libraries to analyze search behavior, deliver contextual responses, and streamline internal workflows. However, there was an equally strong emphasis on the risks posed by AI—particularly in generating inaccurate information or losing the human touch essential to librarianship. The session reinforced the importance of ethical AI adoption, data transparency, and continuous professional engagement to ensure librarians remain in control of how technology shapes user experiences.



On June 28, 2025, the Collaborative Wisdom series addressed the pressing topic of “*Disaster Recovery Management in Libraries*,” with **10 participants**, including invited expert Dr. Shilpa Pandya, Librarian at the Gujarat Institute of Disaster Management. The session emphasized the four key phases of disaster management—prevention, preparation, response, and recovery—and discussed how libraries must assess risks, safeguard unique collections, and align their recovery plans with institutional policies. Real-world examples and strategies were discussed, including pest control, climate balancing, insurance, and mock drills. Dr. Pandya’s insights helped frame a broader vision for library resilience, urging institutions to appoint disaster coordinators and collaborate with formal disaster management bodies. The session ended with a call to build institutional readiness that protects both physical and digital assets in times of crisis.
