It was set up in 1994 with a grant from DSIR, Govt. of India, Delhi, for just the initial years of its inception. The main vision of ADINET is to join libraries and enable them to achieve what cannot be done by one library alone. ADINET organizes many webinars, an annual conference, focus group meetings, and workshops, where library professionals contribute their expertise in societal development and policy formation.
